Hi Friends,

2025 marked a turning point for Wealthsimple Foundation. After years of championing education savings through Canada Learning Bond promotion, we set our sights on helping young people build real financial skills, confidence, and resiliency.

The truth is, today's youth are facing some of the toughest economic headwinds in a generation. Rising costs. Stagnant wages. A financial system that often feels like it wasn't designed for them. And yet, everywhere we go, we meet young people with huge ambition.

That's why we made a strategic shift from education savings promotion to direct money talks, financial education and community-based support, meeting youth where they are, partnering with schools and community organizations, and building the kind of learning experiences that help them unlock opportunity.

And the results speak for themselves: 88 percent would recommend us to a friend and nearly 75 percent of students reported changing a financial habit after taking part in our programming.

Young people told us that they're saving differently, thinking differently, and most importantly, believing in their financial futures.

As we look ahead, and work to improve our program and service delivery, our goal stays the same: Ignite ambition and unlock opportunity to build brighter futures for the next generation of Canadian youth.


